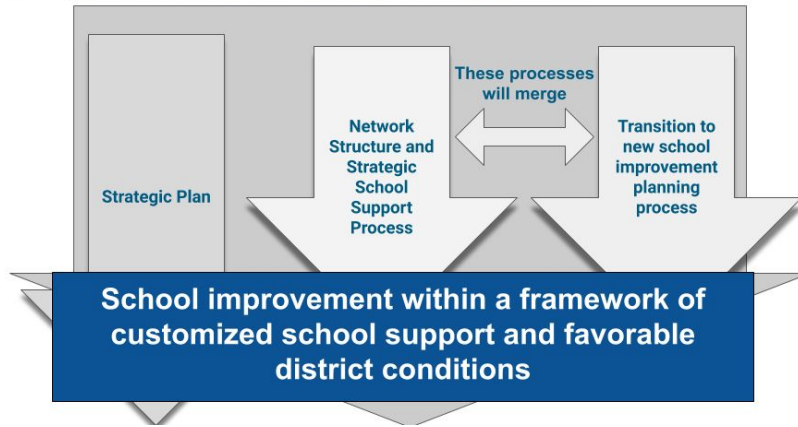

Minutes for Meeting of February 4, 2020

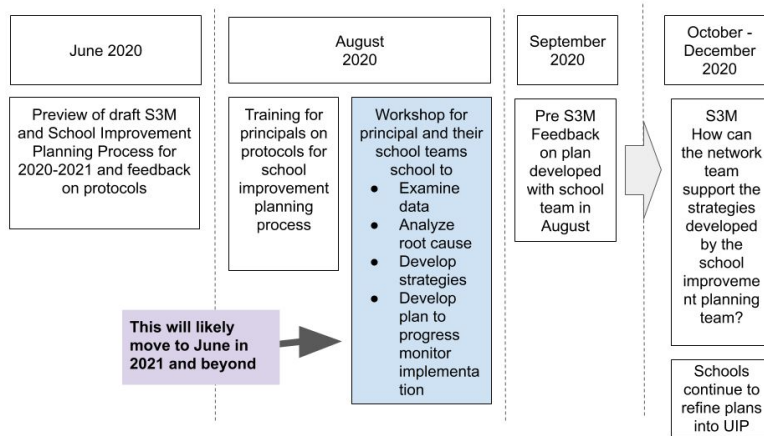
6:15 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.

1. Welcome (Nicole Rajpal, DAC Chair)
 - a. The meeting was called to order at 6:18PM by Nicole.
2. Superintendent's Report & Board of Education Report (Dr. Rob Anderson)
 - a. Sanitas Academy has withdrawn their charter school application. BVSD made several attempts to help find a solution, but in the end, they withdrew from the process.
 - b. Tentative approval has been received for [Senate Bill 204](#) accountability grant
 - c. [Career & Technical Education \(CTE\) presentation](#) made to the board and will be fast tracked through the strategic plan
 - d. District is monitoring the coronavirus; information is available on their [website](#).
 - e. District is looking at major topics regarding transportation, enrollment and budgeting.
 - f. Board of Education received presentations on:
 - i. [Strategic Plan 3C](#) - Academic Return on Investment
 - ii. [updated graduation guidelines](#)
 - g. Board of Education met with the Boulder City Council
3. [School Climate Survey](#) - Brigitte Mutter, Assistant Director of Research & Assessment and Clare Sims, Senior Data Visualization Designer
 - a. Overview of the School Climate Survey was presented that compared BVSD to National data
 - b. Survey collects perception data in general and BVSD is able to desegregate by demographic groups
 - c. Criteria for DAC to review and examine the data was presented for objective sensitivity
 - d. DAC Members had time to work with the data to examine trend and patterns
 - e. Worksheet describing topics of analysis and pattern analysis were used for the analysis.
 - f. Data Analysis subcommittee will explore this data in greater detail
4. Unified Improvement Plan (UIP) - Sam Messier, Area Superintendent - Northwest
 - a. Overview of the strategic school supports (S3M) process was presented
 - b. District is reworking the school improvement process to make it more customized and effective
 - i. This work will be important because there is a high degree of variance from school to school
 - c. Overview of how the S3M work will roll-up into school UIPs was presented.
