



Transfer Admission Requirements

Seven-course pattern

60 semester/90 quarter transferable units minimum

Minimum 2.4 GPA (CA residents) or 2.8 (non-residents)



Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

- Guarantee to a *specific major* at 1 of 6 campuses offering TAG agreements
- Hundreds of major options available







Application available: August 1

Application period: November 1-30


Application fee: \$70 (fee waiver available)/\$80 International

Funding Your Future

- Four types of aid:
 - Grants, Scholarships, Work study, Loads
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - Required for federal & state financial aid.
- California Dream Act Application
 - For CA undocumented students.
 - Opens doors for state and UC financial aid.
- Blue and Gold Opportunity Program
 - Guarantees that UC tuition will be covered by grants and/or scholarships for California students from families with incomes of \$80,000 or less and qualify for financial aid.
- California Middle Class Scholarship
- Merit-based Scholarships
