How To Play:

Remove the Jack, Queen, and King.

Each player gets 5 cards. Players match up cards to make sums of ten. Players take turns asking each other for the missing addend needed to make ten. If player 2 does not have the card, player 1 will "go fish" in the pile of cards in the middle. When a player gets a match, he or she draws another card. If a player runs out of cards, he or she draws two from the pile. The player with the most matches wins.
