

### Example of Work Calendar

**Scenario:** On Monday- English teacher assigned an essay due in one week; Science has a test Friday; Math problems due daily; Theo- Reading and essay due Wed; Spanish has a project due in two weeks.

	<p>DAY1-</p> <p><b>Eng-</b> Review assignment and brainstorm topic and subtopics (in notes)</p> <p><b>Sci-</b> Review what will be on test and break down into small chunks</p> <p>Break</p> <p><b>Math-</b> Complete all math work</p> <p><b>Theo-</b> Read for 15 min. And take notes</p> <p><b>Spanish-</b> Review project.</p>	<p>DAY 2-</p> <p><b>Eng-</b> Work on two body paragraphs- find examples for ideas</p> <p><b>Sci-</b> Study for 30 min.</p> <p>BREAK</p> <p><b>Math-</b> Complete all math work</p> <p><b>Theo-</b> Finish reading and complete essay</p> <p><i>No Spanish today</i></p>	<p>DAY 3-</p> <p><b>Eng-</b> Finish body paragraphs</p> <p><b>Sci-</b> Study for 40 min.</p> <p>BREAK</p> <p><b>Math-</b> Complete all math work</p> <p><b>Spanish-</b> work on project for 1 hour</p> <p><i>No Theo</i> (even if there is an assignment as long as it is not due tomorrow)</p>	<p>DAY 4-</p> <p><b>Eng-</b> Write intro and conclusion</p> <p><b>Sci-</b> Study for 60 min.</p> <p>BREAK</p> <p><b>Math-</b> Complete all work</p> <p><b>Theo-</b> if you have new work</p> <p><b>Spanish-</b> 20 min.</p>	<p>DAY 5-</p> <p><b>Eng-</b> Review and edit essay</p> <p><b>Sci-</b> Begin new assignment; budget about 25 min.</p> <p>BREAK</p> <p><b>Theo-</b> if you have new work</p> <p><b>Spanish-</b> 30 minutes</p>

<b>Eng-</b> Review essay one more time (10 min) <b>Sci-</b> Work on new assignment <b>Math-</b> work on assignment
