## READING

### *Key Ideas & Details*

- Use key ideas and details in texts to support analysis, inferences, themes, central ideas, and summaries.

### *Craft & Structure*

- Analyze dictions, structure, and points of view to determine their contribution to a text.

### *Argument*

- Write arguments to support claims with logical reasons and relevant evidence, using accurate and credible sources and demonstrating an understanding of the topic or text.

### *Informative/Explanatory*

- Write informative/explanatory texts to examine a topic and convey ideas, concepts, and information through the selection, organization, and analysis of relevant content.

## LANGUAGE

### *Conventions of Standard English*

- Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English grammar, usage, mechanics, and spelling when writing or speaking.

### *Knowledge of Language*

- Use knowledge of language to express ideas precisely and concisely, recognizing and eliminating wordiness and redundancy.

### *Vocabulary Acquisition & Use*

- Acquire and accurately use and interpret grade-appropriate words and phrases; gather vocabulary knowledge when considering a word or phrase important to comprehension or expression.
