Minimum Qualifications:

- Applicants must have a graduate degree and at least 18 hours of graduate work in Computer Science and cybersecurity (or relevant industry experience). Ph.D. degree in Computer Science or other relevant field is preferred
- Minimum 2 years of related cybersecurity teaching, training, and/or industry experience
- Knowledge of subject matter and course content pertinent to cybersecurity programs
- Demonstrated record or the potential for excellence in teaching
- Successful candidates must possess excellent verbal and written communication skills

- Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP)
- Certified Authorization Professional (CAP)
- Certified Security Analyst (CSA)
- Certified Information Security Manager (CISM)
