<b>MATH (other)</b>	Verify with High School Counselor	Generally, any 100+ Mathematics course. Verify with your counselor before registering for a math course.
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Verify with High School Counselor	Generally, any 100+ level science course. Survey of Astronomy, Intro to Anatomy & Physiology, Survey of Biology, Chemical Explorations, Survey of Environmental Science, Intro to Physical Geology, Introduction to the Weather, Physics (Basic Concepts).
<b>FINE ARTS</b>	Verify with High School Counselor	Generally, any Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Photography, or Graphic Art class. Verify with your counselor before registering for a Fine Arts course.
<b>WORLD LANGUAGE</b>	Verify with High School Counselor	Any World Language (including Sign Language) offered at a community college above 100.
<b>CAREER &amp; TECH EDUCATION</b>	Verify with High School Counselor	Generally, any 100+ Business, Accounting, Administrative Office Systems, Business Administration, Computer Science, Early Childhood Education, Education, Business Management, Information Technology, Interior Design, Marketing, Media Communications & Technology, and Real Estate courses. Verify with your counselor before registering for an Occupational Education course.
<b>PHYSICAL EDUCATION</b>	Verify with High School Counselor	Generally, any 100+ Physical Education course. Verify with your counselor before registering for a Physical Education course.
