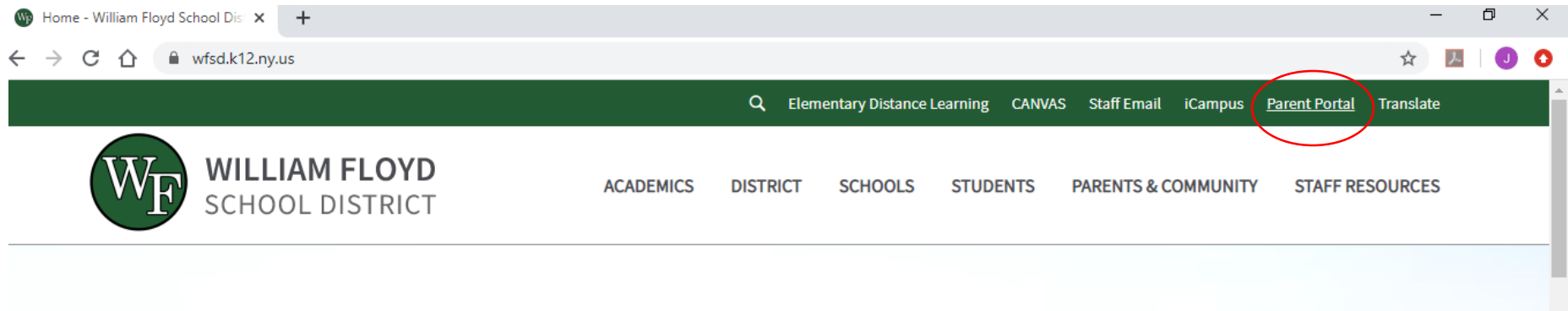




Accessing Report Cards in the I-Campus Parent Portal

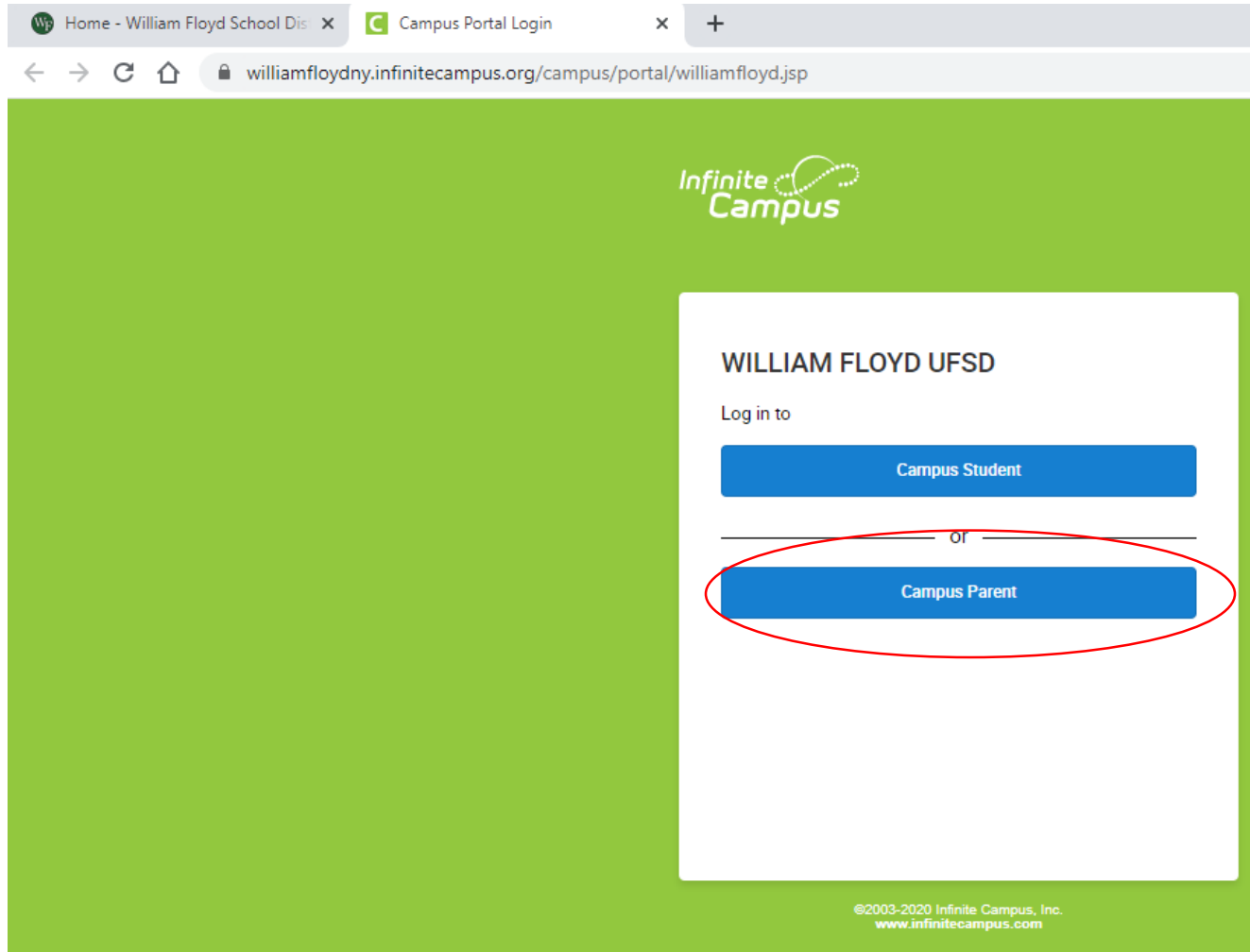
Logging into the Parent Portal





Accessing the Report Card

- Once you have logged into the Parent Portal, select “Reports” from the toolbar on the left hand side.

Important Information for 2019-2020

Per New York State Education Law, additional vaccines will be required for students in September 2019:

- Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4) will be required for all students in grades 7, 8, 9 and 10. A booster will be required at age 16
- Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4) that was administered on or after the student's 16th birthday will be required for all 12th graders
- Students in grades 6 to 12 must provide proof of a Tdap vaccine. Students who are entering 6th grade and who are 11 years of age or older must receive a Tdap vaccine (Tetanus toxoids, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis). Students who are 10 years old and entering 6th grade will not be required to receive the Tdap vaccine until they turn 11 years old. At that time they must provide documentation of the Tdap.
- An additional polio vaccine may be required for students in grades 6 through 11, depending on the intervals of previously received vaccines. Your child's school nurse will advise you if another dose is required.
- An additional DTP vaccine may be required for students in grades K through 5, depending on the intervals of previously received vaccines. Your child's school nurse will advise you if another dose is required.
- A second varicella (chicken pox) vaccine is required for all students in grades K through 11.

Accessing the Report

- If you have multiple children in the district, select which child you would like to view from the drop down on the right side of the screen.
- Then select which report you would like to view.
- Select “Elementary Report Card” to view the K-5 Report Cards.
- Select “Report Card” to view the 6-12 Report Cards.
- The report card will pop up in a new window so ensure you do not have pop ups blocked.
