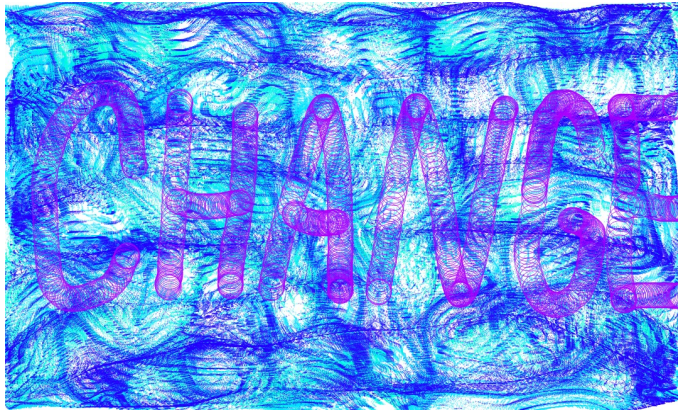


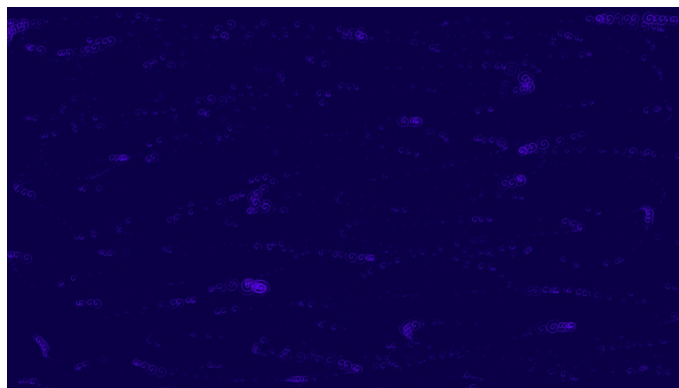

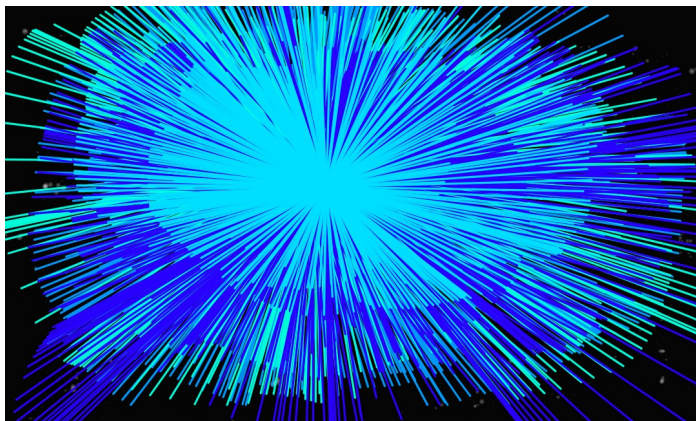
1.) CHANGE
