
Picture Graph - Tally Marks

How to play-

- Find something that can fall down easily (ie toilet paper rolls, stacked blocks, stacked Legos)
- Arrange them into a group (like in bowling).
- Find something that can roll.
- Roll the ball towards the stack, count how many fell down and how many are remaining.
- Write a math equation after every time you bowl.

How many you started with. How many fell down.

How many are left.

Phonics - Rhyme Time

- Parent: Says "Which word rhymes with . . ."
 - Then give them the two options.
- Child: Responds with the word that rhymes.



<u>Cookie Jar Song</u>





- Write down the word 'who' on a paper before singing the song.
- Student: Hold up the word 'who' and sing "Who stole the cookie from the cookie jar? (Then name someone in your family.)
- Family Member sings: "Who me?"
- Student sings: "Yes, you!"
- Family member sings: "Couldn't be."
- Student: Then who?

Continue singing and accusing family members and pets - holding up the word 'who' everytime that word is mentioned in the song."


Writing Practice
