## Ok, its Graduation Day, here's an overview of what you will need to do...

Report to the campus about 30 minutes before your scheduled Graduation time. Remember, each Graduate is allowed two cars for families and loved ones. It is preferred that Graduates do not drive to avoid stopping the traffic flow inside the tailgate area. *Parents will need to remain in the vehicle as there are 388 seniors to honor*. This has to be followed in order to stay compliant with CDC guidelines and to ensure every Graduate's experience is equally special.

- 1. Go to the West Parking Lot and park in the spot that corresponds to your assigned numbers to be lined up for the stadium procession. Teachers will be there to guide you through the process.
- 2. The line moves to the stadium and enters in the tailgate section. Students will get out on the home side to enter the field (again, teachers will direct you, don't worry!) and proceed to the field where the stage is located.
- 3. Students will walk across the stage to get your diploma. Bruckner's will take a photo before you leave the stage.
- 4. After, you will exit the field on the opposite side of the field to their vehicles.
- 5. From there, the procession will move to the front of the school via the Eastside traffic flow.
- 6. Families will be allowed to take a quick family picture with their Graduate by the Bulldog or a Dogs backdrop. Bruckner's photography will also be taking pictures at this location to capture the moment as part of the picture package. BHS will purchase the base picture package for students, and photographs can be purchased from Bruckner's. Parents are welcome to take their pictures as well.

- A free professional picture package which includes two 8x10 photos from Bruckner's Photography (will need to pick up at Bruckner's Studio)
