

Project Graduation will be giving out refunds in addition to the Swag Bags. Students will be required to sign acknowledging receipt of bag and refund. **STUDENTS MUST BE PRESENT TO RECEIVE BAG AND REFUND.** No exceptions!

Want to know what to wear? Start here.

1. Caps are worn parallel to the floor. Our ceremony is very formal, you are not allowed to decorate your cap.
2. Tassels are worn on the left side.
3. All academic cords and stoles must be secured to your robe with pins. Only the cords and stoles given and approved by the school will be worn. (Beta medallion, honors cords, National Honors Society stole, National Vocational Honors Society stole, BHS 2020 stole)
4. Absolutely **NO GUM!**

GUYS

Shirt, Pants, Tie, Socks, Shoes

Pants — Black dress pants. No jeans.

Shirt — White button-up, short or long sleeve. Shirt must have a collar.

Ties — Dark solid color, no bright colors.

Shoes — Solid black, no two-tone colors, no bowling shoes, no tennis shoes, no flip-flops, no work, or camouflage boots.

GIRLS

Dress and Shoes

Dress — Solid, black. No high neckline that will interfere with gown collar, only scoop or v-neck.

Shoes — Black. No two-toned colors. Heels should not be too high—this will eliminate the danger of tripping or stumbling. Do not wear shoes without a backstrap or enclosure.

Jewelry — Unobtrusive or refined--no gaudy or flashy items. (For example, pearl earrings would be fine. Bracelets tend to get caught on the gowns and diplomas. Necklaces will not be visible because of the collar on your robe.)

Purses — should not be brought since they cannot be taken with you into the coliseum or locked up during the ceremony. All money or valuables (cameras) should be given to parents/friends for you during the ceremony.

A representative will be set up to hand you your graduation products at your driver's side window.
