Registering Students For School

How do I know which school my child should be attending?

Students attendance zones are set by the district and can be found on the [SAISD Website](#). All elementaries and middle schools feed into the two high school campuses, Central High School or Lake View High School.

When do I register my child for school?

District wide registration is usually the first or second week of August. Secondary campuses are open throughout the summer except for the week of July 4th. Elementary campuses are open starting the last week of July. Please check campus websites for appropriate dates and times for registration.

What documents do I need to register my child?

Students who are new to the district will need the following documents:

1. Proof of residence (utility bill or lease agreement)
2. Immunization record
3. Withdrawl paperwork from previous school

Students who are returning from the previous school year

1. Proof of residence (utility bill or lease agreement)
2. Immunization record

Who do I contact if my child is receiving services through Special Education, 504 or English as a Second Language programs and are new to the district?

Contact campus counselors and share any documentation from the previous school so that your child's services will continue.
