District Olentangy Local School District, located in southern Delaware County, covers 95 square miles and remains one of the fastest growing districts in Ohio and in the nation. Olentangy Local Schools is ranked in the top 4.1% of all

school districts in the state of Ohio.

School Olentangy High School, a nationally recognized "Blue Ribbon School of Excellence", is a four year public high

school (grades 9-12) with a present enrollment of 1411 students. There are 256 students in the 2020 graduating class.

Olentangy High School ranks in the top 3.9% of high schools in the state of Ohio.

Faculty Olentangy High School has 97 certified staff. Of these, 74% have earned a Master's Degree or beyond.

Graduation The curriculum at Olentangy High school is comprehensive including advanced placement, honors, occupational, and

vocational programs. For the graduating class of 2020, twenty-two credits will be required. Specific requirements

Economics, Macro Economics, Spanish, German and French.
