Children may now be eligible to enroll in subsidized emergency child care.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE

- At-risk population
- Children receiving services from Child Protective Services (CPS) or who are at risk of abuse or neglect
- Children eligible through the Emergency Child Care Bridge Program for Foster Children
- Children experiencing homelessness as defined in the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act
- Children of domestic violence survivors
- Children of essential workers, as defined by the Governor's Executive Order N-33-20, who are unable to work remotely to complete job duties and require child care in order to perform the essential work
- A parent of a child with disabilities or special health care needs whose Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Individualized Family Services Plan (IFSP) includes early childhood education services

Families who meet these requirements may be eligible to receive emergency child care services through June 30, 2020.
