



A NOTE FROM THE MIDDLE SCHOOL OFFICE

Hello again 8th Grade Parents. We are just about ready to go for Monday and I've put together a list of last minute details and reminders for families who will be sending their child to Science Park. As hard as we've tried to cover everything, I am confident there will be a few missed details or last minute surprises, but they will be minor and we will adjust quickly. Please review the information below.

Campus Access - Regulations do not allow us to permit parent or other visitors on campus for the time being. We can always be reached by phone or email though!

Daily Temperature Check at Home - Please take your child's temperature every morning. If they have a fever or are exhibiting other symptoms such as dry cough, sneezing, difficulty breathing, etc., it is critical that your child stay home or see a doctor for medical attention. Please do not send him/her to school.

Masks - Your child should bring 2 masks and his/her own hand sanitizer (optional) every day.

Campus Open Hours - Students cannot enter campus before 7:30 am and then must go directly to their period 1 class. Students must leave the campus at 3:00 pm as there are no after-school activities.

Lunch - Sodexo will provide limited options that should be pre-ordered. If you came to Science Park yesterday, you already made your lunch order for next week and Sodexo will be providing a QR code later next week so you can pre-order online. Although there will be a few extra lunches prepared for students who forget to pre-order, it will really help if you can place the order in advance. Payment can be made via WeChat through the student ID card as before. When we have more students on campus, Sodexo will gradually return to their normal lunch service.

Bus Service - There is currently no bus service but it will resume at a date in the near future.

COVID Test - Students who were not tested at AISG on Thursday must have proof of a negative COVID 19 test result before they can start here on campus.

Day Rotation Calendar - We can't have our two groups of kids (online and in-school) working on different schedules, so everyone will have to return to the published day rotation beginning on Monday. I have created day rotation calendars for each class group. This documents will be very important for students in terms of keeping their work organized. We will follow the same process as we have been during the online period, meaning teachers will only post or make things due on the day/s in the rotation where their class is listed. These will be sent to kids today as well. I know this is a little more confusing than what we've been doing but there was really no way around it.
