 - EPHS Boys Swimming team turned in a great performance at the <u>Class AA State meet</u>. Senior Soren Dunn won two state titles in the 50m and 100m freestyle. Senior Alex Deng finished second in both the 100m butterfly and the 100m breaststroke. The team itself placed in the top five at the tournament.
 - Senior Bryce Dagel placed 4th at the <u>Class AAA State Wrestling meet</u>.
 - Boys basketball player EPHS senior Austin Andrews achieved a major milestone by scoring <u>2,000</u> career points.
 - Eden Prairie High School has been named by Varsity Brands as a finalist in their <u>Spirit of Sportsmanship</u> awards.
 - EPHS junior Luke Mittelstadt was named to the <u>Star Tribune</u> all-metro first team, senior Ben Steeves was named to the all-metro second team and senior John Mittelstadt was named to the all-metro third team.
 - The EPHS Winterguard won first place at the Winter Guard International (WGI) Chicago Regional on March 1 in Scholastic Open with a score of 84.3, the highest ever for an EP team! The Winterguard is also currently in first place in standings nationally in their class among 44 teams.
 - EPHS senior Sydney Lewis has been honored by the National WWII Museum in New Orleans as a 2020 Billy Michal Student Leadership Award recipient.

- EPHS Boys Hockey team had an incredible performance during the <u>Class AA Boys State Hockey</u> <u>Tournament</u> and made it to the finals.



This is the second reading of the capital outlay and building fund budgets for fiscal year 2021. The documents presented include one change from the first reading in March. The Long-Term Facility Maintenance Fund has been adjusted to reflect the prioritization of funds towards the Central Middle School Designing Pathways project.

In keeping with the 2020-21 budget timeline, the capital outlay and building fund budgets are brought to the board for discussion in March and for approval in April. This timeline allows for adequate planning and implementation of projects needed for the 2020-21 school year. Most of larger projects included within the capital budget are spent during the summer months, so approval of this budget is needed earlier than the general operating budget in order to secure bids and quotes.

There are four budget areas within the capital outlay and building funds, mostly due to legal restrictions on the use of the designated revenue streams. Each budget area has its own revenue source and corresponding expenditures aligned to meet the Minnesota Department of Educations' guidelines on appropriate use. See the attached table which shows a breakdown of the budget areas, including the funding source along with a summary of the revenue, expenditures and fund balances for fiscal year 2021.

They represent the district administrations' recommendation of priority projects necessary to achieve the district's academic & facility goals for fiscal year 2021. The budget recommendation is a culmination of the input and prioritization process, which included site administrators, department administrators with direct oversight of the budget areas, and the superintendent's cabinet. Where applicable, the department of education has reviewed and given its approval of certain projects, including health & safety and long-term facility maintenance projects.
