Your responses to the following questions account for 80% of the evaluation/selection process, 15% is based on the quality (grammar, spelling, format, etc.) of your responses, and your GPA is used for the final 5%.

- Describe the institution or training program you want to attend after high school.
- How will your plan/field of study help you toward a successful future?

2. ACADEMICS: (10 pts)

- Explain how your academic studies have prepared you for, or guided you toward, your post high school plans.

3. SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: (20 pts)

- Describe extracurricular activities you participated in (e.g., clubs, athletics, scouts etc.). How has your participation in those activities shaped your post high school plans or benefited your community?
- What activities, experiences or interests have been the most significant or meaningful to you, and why?
