2020 Scholarship FAQs

Q. WHAT IS FAPSETA?

A. The Faribault Area Public Schools Educational Trust Association's (FAPSETA) purpose is to expand access to higher education for students of Faribault High School and Faribault Area Learning Center through a variety of scholarship offerings available to seniors. FAPSETA has been awarding scholarships since 1988.

Q. CAN A STUDENT RECEIVE MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP?

A. Yes. A student can receive more than one scholarship.

Q. HOW MANY STUDENTS APPLY EACH YEAR?

A. While the number of applications varies from year to year, approximately 100 students apply.

Q. ARE SCHOLARSHIPS ALWAYS BASED ON GPA?

A. No. There are several scholarships that are not based on GPA. We encourage <u>ALL</u> Faribault High School seniors to review the various scholarships available and apply.

Q. WHO REVIEWS THE APPLICATION/DECIDES HOW TO AWARD SCHOLARSHIPS?

A. A committee from the FAPSETA Board sits on the Scholarship Selection Committee and reviews all the applications confidentially.

Q. HOW DO YOU QUALIFY FOR FINANCIAL NEED SCHOLARSHIPS?

A. Scholarships based on financial need, will require that you submit your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) reported on the front page of your **Student Aid Report (SAR)**. After you complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), a SAR is generated. To qualify for any financial need scholarships, a copy of the SAR must be submitted and included with the application in order to qualify for "need based."

Q. WHO SEES MY INFO/DO THEY KNOW MY NAME?

A. All identifying information is removed, and a number assigned to each application prior to the scholarship committee reviewing applications.

O. IS THE SELECTION PROCESS FAIR?

A. To avoid any conflict of interest, no one on the Scholarship Selection Committee is allowed to have a graduating senior of their own applying for a scholarship. The Selection Committee uses criteria set forth by the donors to determine who is in the pool for each scholarship. Scholarships are awarded to the most deserving students, with higher level scholarships going to those students who represent the highest level of achievement per the criteria of each scholarship.

Q. HOW AND WHEN ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS RECEIVED?

A. All scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Awards Night on <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>MAY 20th</u>, at 6:00 pm in the <u>Performing Arts Center</u>. Students <u>will not know</u> if they have received a FAPSETA scholarship prior to the Awards Night. Parents are invited to share in the event and, in many cases, students will be able to meet and thank their donor. This is a formal event, and students will be expected to wear their cap and gown.

Q. HOW ARE THE CHECKS DISTRIBUTED?

A. After the Awards Night, the students will complete a form indicating the school of their choice. Checks will be mailed to their school and a copy of this check will be sent to the student as a receipt of acknowledgement.
