3D Printing & CAD with Steamworks Studio: \$175

Grades 3-5, Mondays, 2:00-3:00 PM, April 13 - June 1

Using just a computer, students can access Google's SketchUp through which they will learn how to design in 3D! Our instructor will walk them through all the basic tools which will be used to create fun simple projects including name tags, miniature houses & skyscrapers, and geometric pencil holders. We will print the designs in-house and ship them to the students.

Learn Cartooning with Steamworks Studio: \$175

Grades K-5, Tuesdays, 2:00-3:00 PM, April 14 - June 2

For this course, all students would need is a pencil and paper. Our instructor, Mr Dave will also provide printable templates for the students to work off of. Mr Dave will teach the students how to create fun, animated characters in a step-by-step manner using simple shapes and guidelines, and will provide feedback on student work.

BEGINNING BALLET with Ms. Box: \$200

Grades K-5, Wednesdays, 2:00-2:45 PM, April 8 - June 3

Ballet supports developing coordination, balance, flexibility, strength, and memorization. Students will learn beginner ballet technique, exploring the style through basic positions and movements. Together, they will create a ballet routine to be performed at the end of the session. What to wear: Comfortable clothing, flexible shoes (ballet shoes if possible).

GAME THEORY with Mr Anton: \$200

Grades K-5, Thursdays, 2:00-3:00 PM, April 9 - June 4

Love video games? Instead of just consuming video games, students will learn what it takes to build them! During this session, students will focus on computer coding. Using the program Scratch, students will collaborate to develop their own ideas and code a simple game. This is a fun opportunity to combine math and games. 10 Max

INTRODUCING WEST AFRICAN DRUMMING with Baba M: \$150 for 6 weeks

Grades K-5, Fridays, 2:00 - 3:00PM, May 1

Students will learn multiple rhythms and drumming techniques from a Drumming Master! The class will consist of a half hour or so, Live Zoom meeting followed by a video "Episode" (created by the teacher and viewed on his website) for the students to reinforce the skill they will have just learned in class.

If your child does not have a drum, to best participate in the course parents should locate or buy an empty plastic 5 gallon bucket to use as a drum, and some 7/8 dowels to cut into 14 inch sticks (materials should cost under \$10). If you are unable to acquire a plastic bucket or dowels, students can still participate, but will need to use something else in the home to drum on.
