



Are you ready to continue your education in Boston? Here are your next steps!

1. Apply for admission

Submit your transfer online application at apply.fisherfalcons.org.

2. Fill out a FAFSA

99% of our students receive financial aid. Complete your FAFSA at studentaid.gov and add Fisher College's school code (002150) to secure financial assistance.

3. Send in your transcripts

- Official final high school transcript or GED (except for applicants who have earned an associate's degree)
- Official transcript(s) from each college/university attended

4. Receive your acceptance letter

If admitted, you will receive an immediate priority merit scholarship of up to \$23,000!

Mass-Transfer Community College Guarantee

If you have earned your associate's degree from a Massachusetts Community College with a minimum 2.5 GPA, your admission to Fisher College is guaranteed.

5. Receive your official credit evaluation

Accepted transfer students are guaranteed a 48-hour turnaround on credit evaluations. Our flexible credit policy allows students to transfer up to 90 credits from an accredited institution.

Grade Requirements

In general, a "C-" in a college-level course is the minimum grade required to transfer that course. We also have several articulation agreements in place to ease the transfer process for students.

6. Review your financial aid offer

An education at Fisher is just as affordable as any state university after financial aid. Not only will you benefit from our small class sizes and strong academic support services, you will be able to live and study in America's greatest college city.

7. Make it official - submit your deposit!

Students who deposit by May 1 are guaranteed College housing and/or a seat in our upcoming class. Unfortunately after May 1, these spots are filled on a first come, first serve basis and cannot be guaranteed.
