Each pupil chooses three A level subjects from the following (if you are choosing *Further Maths please do not choose Maths*):

Pupils in the Remove (Year 12) are expected to follow an A level Plus programme in which they choose two courses over one year that provide an opportunity for them to fire their enthusiasm and become experts in areas that lie just beyond the reach of the normal curriculum.

At the end of the Remove, pupils will complete their Extended Essay or Extended Project Qualification which is assessed in the first term of the Upper Sixth (Year 13).

In addition to A level subjects, all pupils follow a Liberal Studies course over two years. These lessons will be taught in conjunction with James Allen's Girls' School as a non-examined course.
