## Getting Started at Highline College

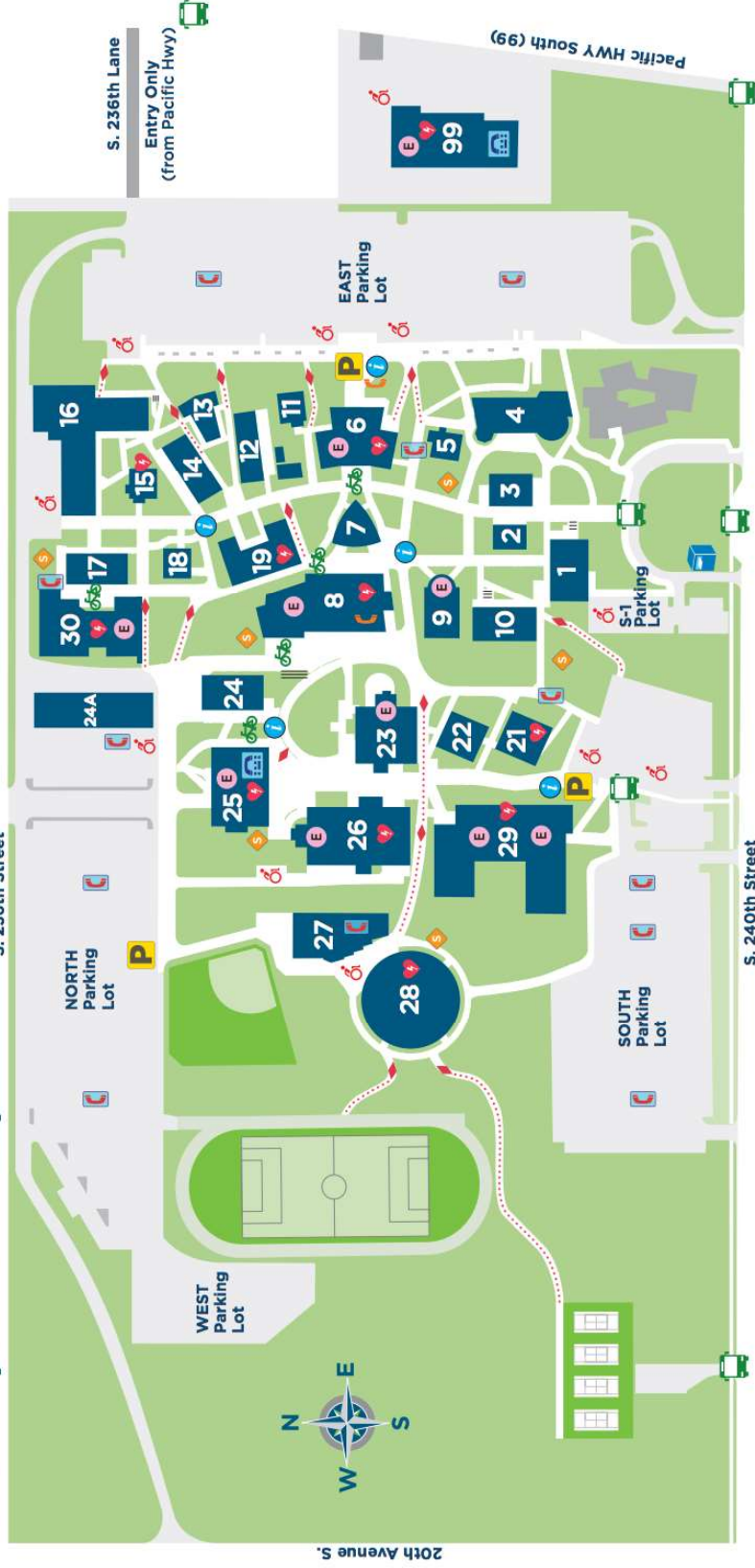
## Where can I get involved on campus?
