# Sound Acquisition Chart

Age	Sounds mastered (in beginning, middle, & end of words)
<b>3 to 4</b>	m, n, p, b, t, d, k, g, w, h & vowels
<b>5 to 6</b>	f, sh, ch, l, l-blends
<b>7</b>	v, j, s, z, s-blends, ing
<b>8</b>	r, r-blends, th

## Vocabulary and Sentences

12-18 months first words

2 years 2 word sentence 50-word vocabulary

3 years 3-4 word sentence 400-900 word vocabulary

5 years 5-6 word sentence 1500-2500 words

After age 5, the child rapidly advances. The child understands many more words than he can say. Remember, these are general guidelines, and each child will vary.
