

2nd Grade Literacy Activities for the Week of May 4-8

In reading, we are working on our fluency. Fluent readers read smoothly, pause at the right times, and read with expression. When our reading sounds right, we understand what we read better. In writing, students will review strategies for choosing what to write and planning their writing. In phonics, students will study R-controlled vowels.

On days where there is not a reading or writing lesson, we've suggested an amount of independent practice time that would be appropriate for most 2nd graders. Please adjust these to your child's learning needs.
