Math: Shake and Spill Game

Materials Needed:

- **5-10 pennies**
- **Cup**
- **Paper**
- **Pencil**



How to Play:

1. Place 5 pennies in a cup and shake them.
2. spills the pennies out on the playing space
3. Count the number of heads and the number of tails
4. After you count tell what you counted "I have 4 heads and 1 tail. 4 and 1 makes 5"
5. Have your partner take a turn or do it again!
6. Try recoding combinations with pictures or numbers.
7. Add more pennies between 5 – 10 for extra practice.
