

## Tips for Fluency Practice

If you are unable to print out a game, copy the game onto a piece of paper.

Partners should check each other's answers using a multiplication chart or players can draw an array or picture.

If you don't have dice, you can:

- Make and use numeral cards instead. Cut paper into squares and write one number (0-10) on each square
- Use virtual dice. <https://dice.virtuworld.net>

Many games call for game pieces called counters. Students can use coins, bottle caps, paper clips, or game pieces from games at home.
