### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

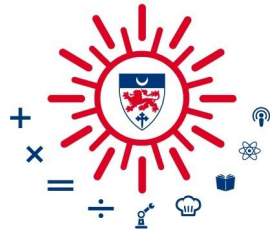

Children will learn Korean through exploring the world using their five senses. It is a perfect chance for children to learn 'real' Korean language through C.A.M.P (cooking, art, music, performance).

Children will have a mini-exhibition at the end of the summer term, children can create a little gallery walk to present their work at the C.A.M.P. Invite the parents and celebrate their journey together.

**Grade 3 - 5 PROGRAM: EVERYTHING IS AWESOME!**  
**FIRST SESSION: JUNE 15 - JUNE 26**

**PROGRAM OUTLINE:** Every day the excitement of learning will build through the world of LEGO! Students will expand on their reading skills each day, and strengthen their writing skills as they create the next great LEGO movie. Mathematical skills will be improved by solving critical number problems to support the planning and building of their LEGO characters and story set. Students will learn important STEM concepts and gain important hands-on problem-solving skills while developing their creativity, confidence and excitement for STEM. Imagination and creativity will abound as



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students build cool models, develop their movie and make it come to life through their own animation!

## **Grade 3 - 5 PROGRAM: FAMILY GAMES NIGHT!**

**SECOND SESSION: JUNE 29 - JULY 10**

**PROGRAM OUTLINE:** Do you love games? How about board games? Ever dream about inventing your own board game with its own unique concept? How about using the school's Makerspace to make your vision a reality? In this Numeracy and Literacy course, we will combine mathematics, reading, writing, listening, speaking, inquiry, and design to create your very own board game. Did I mention we will also PLAY board games to discover and experience how math and literacy are already integrated? The best part? You get to take your game home with you!

## **SCHOOL OF ROCK Grades 3 - 5**

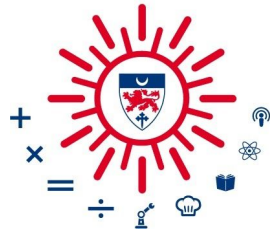
### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

Have you seen the School of Rock? Drop everything, grab a mic or instrument, and make some music this summer! In this program, students will become a member of a live band and develop essential music-making skills. Based on the revolutionary new teaching method called "Music as a Second Language", **Modern Band** follows a student-centered approach that teaches students to play the popular musical styles they know and love, including rock, hip-hop, and pop. **Modern Band** is a program where students will not only make music and jam, but also be part of a live performance, featuring guitar, ukulele, bass, keyboard, drums, vocals, and technology.

## **SWIM LESSONS / SWIM TRAINING**

### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

Beginner Swim Lessons - Students will learn basic water safety and swimming skills, including floating, gliding, and basic freestyle. (30 minutes in water, maximum 8 students). **Students of all Grades - Afternoon**



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Intermediate Swim Lessons - Students with previous swimming experience will expand their knowledge and skills through further development of the four competitive swim strokes. (45 minutes in water, maximum 10 students). **Grade 4 - 8 - Afternoon**

Competitive Swim Training - For students, with extensive swimming experience and training, will complete this training focused on fine-tuning stroke work, flip turns, and race strategy. This is perfect for students considering competitive swimming. (1 hour in water, maximum 12 students). **Grade 4 - 10 - Morning**

All lessons will be held at DMC Ville pool.

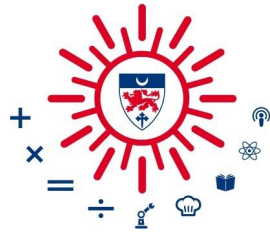

## FEE SCHEDULE:

Dwight School Seoul students are eligible for registration in the Dwight Summer Academy. Each Grade level Program requires a minimum of 7 students to operate.



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Additional sections of the program will open based on the number of registrations. To guarantee your child's placement in a Dwight's Summer Academy session we encourage all families to complete registration as soon as possible.

- Registration deadline and full payment is due by **May 22, 2020**
- Payment is paid in Korean Won
- A late fee of KRW 50,000 will be assessed per registration after May 22nd, 2020
- **Lunch and snack fee is included in the Summer Academy tuition**
- Bus fee is separate and optional
