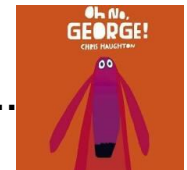

Dip a cotton bud into soap and then into one of the food colour spots in your tray for about 15 seconds. Watch what happens! Talk to a grown up about what you see! Can you then paint or make draw and colour it.</p>	<p>VE Day Friday 8th May BBC Newsround have some photos you can look at together.
