Join a video meeting

Join a video meeting in Classroom

If your teacher turns on Meet for Classroom, you can join a video meeting for your class. You can't join a class video meeting until the teacher starts the meeting.

To use Meet, you have to sign in to Classroom with a school account. Your account looks like *you@thevillageschool.net*.

- 1. Go to classroom.google.com.
- 2. Click the class.
- 3. Choose an option:

On the Stream page, at the top, click the Meet link.

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On the Classwork page, at the top, click Meet .

On an announcement or post, click the link for the class video meeting.

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- 4. (Optional) To allow Meet to use your camera and microphone, click Allow.
- 5. Before joining the meeting, in the top-right corner, check that you're signed in with your Classroom account. If not, switch to your Classroom account.
- 6. To join the class video meeting, click Join now.

To leave the video meeting, in Meet, click Leave call .

Join with a meeting link or invitation

1. Choose an option:

If your teacher shared a meeting link, click the link or paste it into your browser.

If your teacher sent an invite in an email message, in the message, click the link or Join Meet.

- 2. In Meet, in the top corner, make sure you're signed in with your school account. If you're already signed in and need to switch accounts, click **Switch account**.
- 3. Click Join now.

Join with a meeting nickname

If your teacher or the meeting organizer shared a meeting nickname, you use the nickname to join the meeting.

- 1. Open Google Meet.
- Sign in with your school account. If you're already signed in and need to switch accounts, in the top-right corner, click your profile > Switch account.
- 3. Click Use a meeting code > enter the meeting nickname > click Continue.
- 4. Click Join now.
