Grade 10, Credit 1.0

Prerequisite: C or better on Environmental Science.

Biology is the study of life. This course is designed to stimulate reasoning and a better understanding of major biological topics and concepts. Topics studied include cellular biology, biochemistry, genetics, evolution, taxonomy, classification, human anatomy, and ecology. Throughout the course, Instructional strategies will emphasize inquiry-based experiments, techniques as well as modeling exercises, projects and problem-solving exercises.

An EOC will be taken at the end of the course and will count as **30% of their final grade**. Biology is a required course for graduation.
