

SPANISH II - 0708350

Grade 9-12, Credit 1.0

Prerequisite: 75% or higher on preceding levels of Spanish

Spanish II reinforces the fundamental skills acquired by the students in Spanish I. The course develops increased listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills as well as cultural awareness. Specific content to be covered is a continuation of listening and oral skills acquired in Spanish I. Reading and writing receive more emphasis, while oral communication remains the primary objective. The cultural survey of the target language speaking people is continued.

This is a continuation of level one with additional practice in speaking, reading and writing. Extensive grammatical concepts are addressed, in addition to vocabulary that is more sophisticated and advanced verb tenses. The content includes, but is not limited to:

- Conversational expression of feelings, ideas, and opinions
- Comprehension of spoken and written language
- Oral and written presentation of information and ideas, in the target language, to an audience
- Social interaction patterns within the Spanish Speaking culture
- Communication patterns of languages
- Spanish language usage within and beyond the school setting
