

AP US HISTORY - 2100330

Grade 11-12, Credit 1.0

Prerequisite: Placement in this course requires a 3 or above on the FSA ELA.

Advanced Placement (AP) World History is a college-level course offered as a substitute to general World History, and is typically taken in the sophomore year by those students seeking to earn college credit by taking the APWH examination. This exam is offered nationally by the College Board in the spring semester. AP World at Sarasota Military Academy is intended to be the second of three AP courses offered in the social studies, between AP Human Geography and AP United States History.

Students will be assessed at the anticipated difficulty level of the College Board examination, and as such should expect this course to be a high-difficulty course with a mandatory time commitment outside of the classroom. Despite its difficulty, however, AP World is intended to be the most comprehensive study of the human story that is possible, given the time constraints of a semester class.
