# ABCABC Pattern

### Phonics – Isolating Final Sounds

#### <u>Parent</u>:

Read the sentence.

Then ask them what the last sound they hear at the end of each sentence is.

#### Example

Parent: "Pam came home."

What is the last sound in the sentence? Student: "m" (student should respond with the sound and not the letter name)

## Sight Word Practice



### <u>Go Fish</u>



Write the sight words twice on a small paper or index card.

#### Dirctions. Shuffle the cards.

- (Goal- to find a matching word to those words that you hold in your hand.)
- Hand out 6 cards to each player.
- Each player will take turns asking another player -if they have a word that you hold in your hand.
- If the player has the matching card they give you that card and you keep the two matching words in your 'winning pile.'
- If the placyer does not have the card, they say "Go Fish." This means you draw a new card from the uncovered deck.
- Proceed to the next player.
- Once a player wins a matching word for all of their cards, they win.

Have your child write one to two sentences following the sentence starter.
