The Health Science Pathway gives students the opportunity to explore the healthcare industry while focusing on medical and lab procedures, medical terminology, anatomy, physiology, and infection control.

Students will participate in clinical rotations at local hospitals and have the choice to enroll in a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) or Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) program to obtain an industry certification while still in high school. To further their understanding of the medical field, students can also join the HOSA-Future Health Professionals organization for leadership and competitive opportunities


