### **Grade K - 2 PROGRAM: YOUNG EINSTEINS!** **SESSION 1: JUNE 15 - 26**

#### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

In this program, our young Scientists and Engineers will learn to use their imagination and think critically to solve problems and complete a range of science experiments, all while improving their **reading skills**. Students will read a story, and identify a challenge, experiment, or task from that story. They will then use their **mathematical, science, and engineering** skills in the design cycle to find a solution! (i.e. Build strong bridges for the Billy Goats Gruff). The students will develop the mindset that "The important thing is to not stop questioning. Curiosity has its own reason for existing." - Albert Einstein

### **Grade K - 2 PROGRAM: DWIGHT SUMMER ACADEMY ESCAPE ROOM!** **SESSION 2: JUNE 29 - JULY 10**

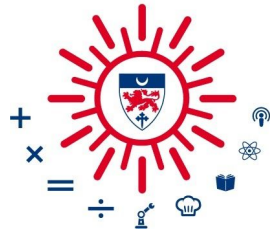
#### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

In this program, our young spies will use their reading, writing, and mathematical skills, to solve problems and play games that will assist them in escaping from the Dwight Summer Academy escape room! They will have to work together as a team to critically think and strategize how they put all of the pieces of the puzzle together to find their way out. The spies will also each have a chance to create their own room for others to try and escape from. Literacy and Numeracy will not be contained within any four walls!

### **PROGRAM: Korean C.A.M.P (cooking, art, music, performance) Grades K - G2** **BOTH SESSION 1 & SESSION 2**

#### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

Are you looking for a creative and fun class for children to learn Korean? Playful, colorful, tasty, and totally hands-on, **C.A.M.P** is designed for children to develop their Korean skills through creative thought, to inspire imagination, encourage self-expression, and foster artistic potential. Children learn valuable practical 'real world'



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Korean skills, through fun and communal activities. Children will be inspired to expand their creations and to experiment with the Korean language.

Children will learn Korean through exploring the world using their five senses. It is a perfect chance for children to learn 'real' Korean language through C.A.M.P (cooking, art, music, performance).

Children will have a mini-exhibition at the end of the summer term, children can create a little gallery walk to present their work at the C.A.M.P. Invite the parents and celebrate their journey together.

## **K - 2 MUSIC: Recorder Ensemble**

### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

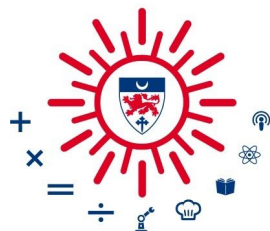
The recorder can be the gateway instrument for many young aspiring and developing musicians. Among other benefits, recorder playing helps us develop strong lungs and breath control as well as our listening and fine motor skills. While introducing basic skills of recorder play, this course will engage students in the reading, practice and performance of a range of musical styles, including classical, folk and pop music. Learning the recorder in an ensemble setting from an early age is fun and fosters essential musical skills.

## **SWIM LESSONS / SWIM TRAINING**

### **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

Beginner Swim Lessons - Students will learn basic water safety and swimming skills, including floating, gliding, and basic freestyle. (30 minutes in water, maximum 8 students). **Students of all Grades - Afternoon.** All lessons will be at DMC Ville pool.

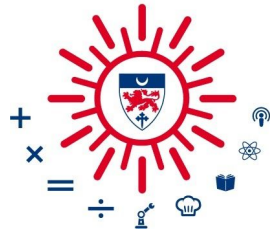

## FEE SCHEDULE:

Dwight School Seoul students are eligible for registration in the Dwight Summer Academy. Each Grade level Program requires a minimum of 7 students to operate. Additional sections of the program will open based on the number of registrations. To guarantee your child's placement in a Dwight's Summer Academy session we encourage all families to complete registration as soon as possible. We will register students on a first-come-first-served basis.

- Registration deadline and full payment is due by **May 22, 2020**
- Payment is paid in Korean Won
- A late fee of KRW 50,000 will be assessed per registration after May 22nd, 2020
- Lunch and snack fee is included in the Summer Academy tuition
- Bus fee is separate and optional
