

AAHS Boys Golf Expectations

Mission Statement:

It is the mission of the AAHS Golf Program to be a competitive program while developing the skills of young players, instilling the values of good citizenship, fair and honest play, and an increased appreciation of the game.

Policies and Expectations:

- 1) Attend practices
 - a. Unexcused absences will result in meet suspension and/or dismissal from the team.
 - b. If you need to miss a practice, it is the golfer's responsibility to contact the coaches – NOT a team member.
 - c. Academics are important! Schedule time before and after practice/meets to complete work
 - d. It is the players responsibility to maintain acceptable academic performance.
- 2) Golf Course Expectations
 - a. Follow clubhouse and grounds rules, and respect other members.
 - b. Remember it is a privilege that we are allowed to play and practice at these courses.
- 3) Always conduct yourself in an honest and respectful manner. You are not only representing yourself but your coaches, team, schools, and communities.
 - a. Be honest, positive, and respectful.
 - b. All players will remain in the clubhouse for results of meets and thank the coach and course manager for hosting.
 - c. Be sure to maintain a reasonable pace of play.
 - d. Win humbly and lose graciously
 - e. SUPPORT YOUR TEAMMATES
- 4) Dress Code
 - a. Make sure to dress appropriately for practices and meets.
 - i. Polo shirts and golf shorts/pants. Jackets/sweatshirts and other outerwear should also be appropriate. **NO** tank tops, athletic shorts, sweatpants, or scrubby clothes.
 - ii. Meets: Team polo shirts and khaki/black shorts/pants are required, hats need to be AAHS or golf related.
- 5) Qualifying for the varsity and JV team will be done using the following criteria:
 - a. Coaches observations during practices and meets, performance in previous meets, attendance, attitude, and playoff holes if needed.
