## Seniors' Last Day

# **Graduation Commencement Ceremony**

The original graduation date of *May 31st has been cancelled*. In an effort to provide seniors and their families with the best possibility of a traditional graduation ceremony, the decision was made to move the date back. *Please save the date* for *August 2, 2020 at 10:00 AM* for the graduation ceremony for the class of 2020. We are planning for various scenarios including a live, in-person ceremony with an audience, a live ceremony without an audience, a drive through live ceremony, and a virtual ceremony. No decisions have been made yet, so we want to be prepared for all possibilities.

# **Yearbooks**

Yearbook printing has been delayed, and we have an approximate date of late June for their arrival. This date is still flexible and we will share more information as we receive it. Once we have the yearbooks and know more about social distancing guidelines, we will share the plan for distribution.

### **School Materials and Personal Items**

Once the stay at home order has been lifted and social distancing recommendations clarified, we will share the plan for students to return books, materials, and Chromebooks. Additionally, we will arrange for students to pick up personal belongings and important items. Look for more information from us in June.

# **Caps and Gowns**
