

Returning to the Lower School on May 11, 2020: Important procedures for your safety!

▶ Coming to School



Arrival

There will be two drop-off points and two distinct windows of time for arrival:

Lower parking lot:

EC students and older siblings: 8:30–8:45
KG students and older siblings: 8:45–9:00

Upper parking lot:

Grades 1–2 students and older siblings: 8:30–8:45
Grades 3–5 students and older siblings: 8:45–9:00

- Parents must use the designated car park, based on the grade level of the *youngest child* in the family.
- Parents need to remain in their cars.
- All students arriving late (after 9:00) will need to enter the school building alone, through the main entrance, to be signed in by reception.

▶ Leaving from School



Departure

There will be two pick-up points and two distinct windows of time for departure:

Lower parking lot:

EC students and older siblings: 13:00–13:15
KG students and older siblings: 13:20–13:30

Upper parking lot:

Grades 1–2 students and older siblings: 13:00–13:15
Grades 3–5 students and older siblings: 13:20–13:30

- Parents must use the designated car park, based on the grade level of the *youngest child* in the family.
- Parent need to remain in their cars and display an A4 sign with their child's name and class in the windshield.

▶ Transportation



ZIS Bus Service

There will be no ZIS bus service to and from the Lower School until further notice.

▶ While at School



Health and Hygiene

- Students must stay home if they, or anyone in their household, are displaying symptoms of COVID-19
- Students must be free of symptoms for 48 hours before returning to school
- Students and teachers must wash their hands regularly
- Increased cleaning protocols will be in effect
- Parent and visitors will not be allowed in the school building



Continuous Learning Plan

- We will maintain our academic provision through the CLP
- All students will continue to work on the material shared as part of the CLP
- Students unable to attend school in person will join the Morning Meeting via Google Meet and will continue to access learning through Seesaw
- Art, Music, PE and German will continue to share activities via the CLP



Classes

- Homeroom groups of 15 or fewer will remain together as one cohort
- Homeroom groups of 16 or more will be divided into two cohorts
- All cohorts of students will have two teachers
- For split classes, the homeroom teacher will be the primary instructor for both, moving between the two groups
- Opportunities for social connections and emotional support will be offered



Play and Snack

- Each class will have outside play time every day
- Students will stay in their class group in a defined area of the playground
- A teacher will supervise each class during these play times
- Students will eat snack in the classroom
- The cafeteria will be closed



What to Bring

Each day, students must bring:

- A large snack (or two) and a water bottle
- Rain gear
- Spare set of clothing for students in EC to Grade 2
- Fully charged iPad (Grades 1–5). These will be cleaned and contact will be restricted to the owner of the device
