On Tuesday, May 5, Governor Ned Lamont announced all in-person classes at all public school facilities in Connecticut will remain cancelled for the rest of the 2019-2020 academic year.

In keeping with this decision, Goodwin Magnet Schools will remain closed and continue to implement our approach to ongoing educational opportunities until the scheduled last day of school for each school and program. Currently, Goodwin Magnet School Administration and School leadership are planning and reviewing end of the year protocols to ensure that we can close school ensuring that faculty, staff and students can perform or fulfill any necessary end of the year procedures in a safe and orderly fashion.
