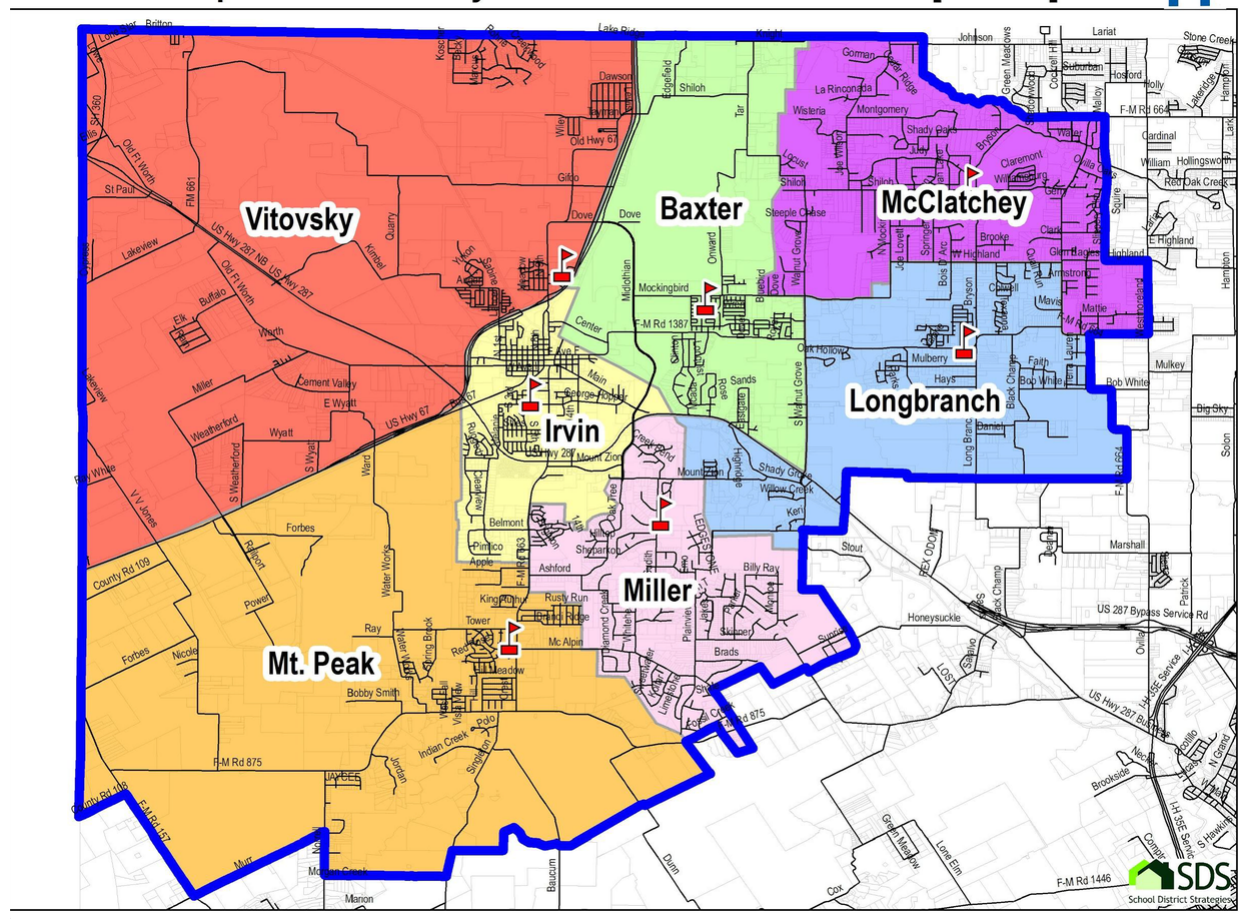

Middle School No. 3 Zoning Committee

With Middle School No. 3 opening in August 2020, MISD will charge a community committee to make a recommendation for the middle school attendance boundaries. The committee will represent each elementary zone from both large and small subdivisions, and participation will be determined by a nomination process and a lottery.

2019 Committee Timeline

- August - Begin the nomination process and selection
- September - October - Weekly committee meetings
- October - Present initial recommendation to the Board
- October - November - Community input and committee review
- November - Committee makes the final recommendation to the Board
- December - Board takes final action on the attendance zones
