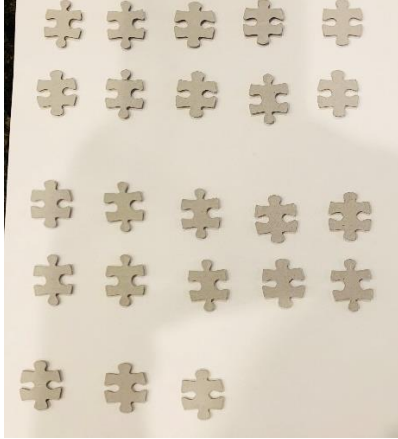
Math-

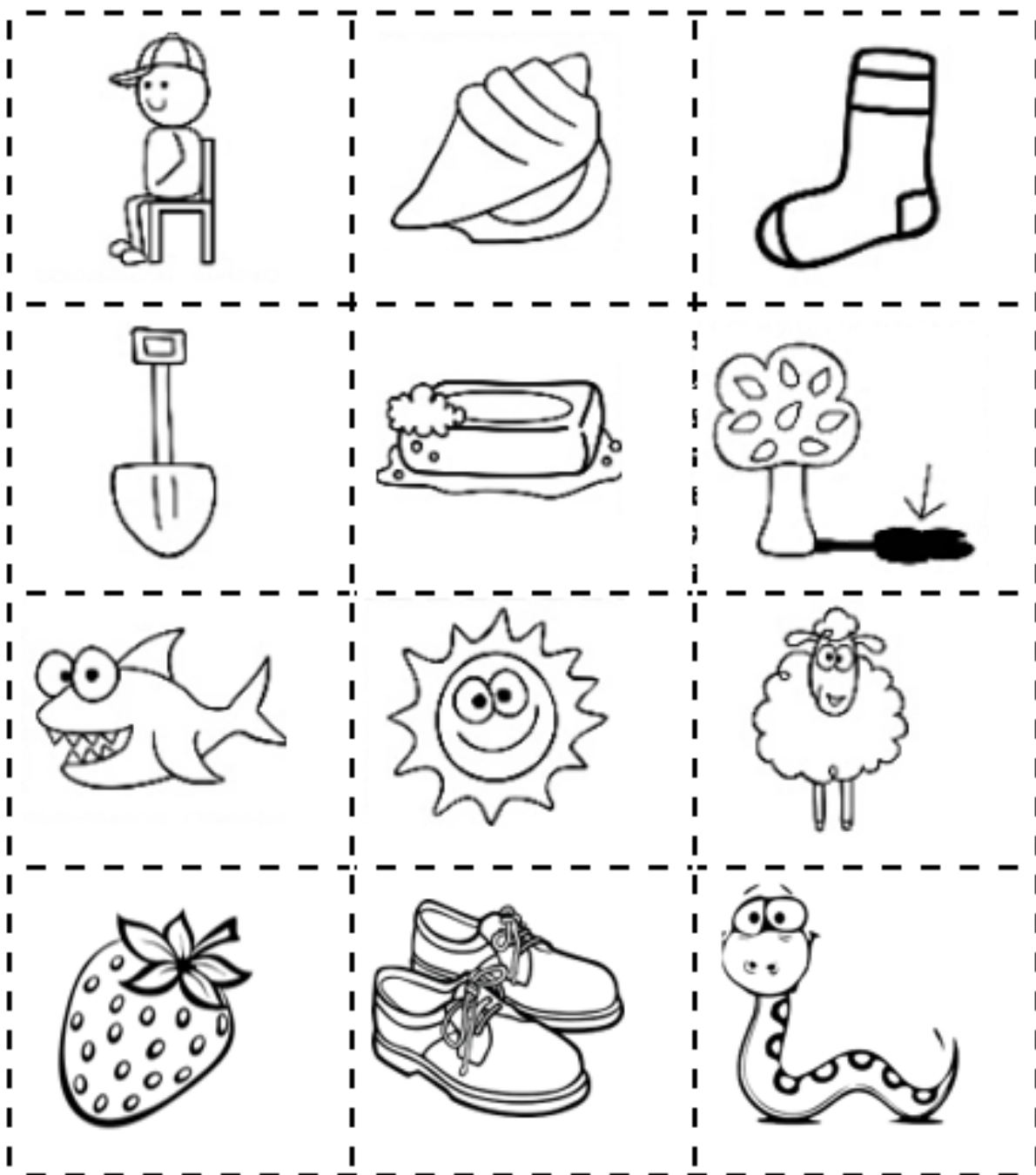
