### **Grab-N-Go Lunches (11am -1pm on Monday, Wednesday & Friday)**

We will continue to serve two Grab & Go lunches per child on each day for Monday and Wednesday and one lunch on Friday in the TCHS Student Parking Lot on Temple City Blvd. **Please drive through and remain in your car.** Any students who need to walk to the lunch service will be given special directions for picking up lunch. If a parent can show the student's school ID card, we will serve the lunch to the adult on behalf of the student in case the student cannot be present. No ID card is necessary if the child is present. **Please keep in mind that on Monday, May 25, 2020, we will not be serving lunch in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.** Lunch service will resume on Wednesday, May 27, 2020.

### **Fourth Quarter Progress Reports Now Available for Oak Intermediate**

Parents and students may now log into your [Aeries Parent Portal](#) account to review the most recent reporting period. After logging in, click "Grades" on the top bar. Then choose "Grades" again and click the printer icon in the right top corner. You will be able to see all marks for the year up through the progress report for the fourth quarter. If a student does not have marks for the progress report, the student is not in danger of not receiving credit. Some teachers included all marks as a way for students and parents to know where they stand. If you have any questions regarding the marks on the progress report, please contact the teacher for that course.
