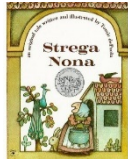
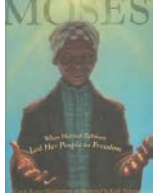
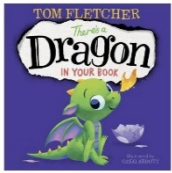

Make a drawing or 3 dimensional model of a source of water and send a picture to your teacher.
