VIRTUAL SUMMER SCHOOL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Virtual classes open June 16, 2020 beginning at 10am
- Proctored final exams will be virtual. You will set final exams up with your mentor teacher.
- Students taking ONE virtual course must complete their final exam on or before July 28, 12pm.
- Students taking TWO virtual courses must complete their final exam for their first course by July 8, 12pm, and will not be allowed to begin their second course until that final exam is completed and recorded.
- Students taking TWO virtual courses must complete the final exam for their second course by July 30, 12pm.
- \$229 in district per CLASS / \$267 out of district per CLASS - for 2020 Summer School ALL change and drop fees have been waived.

Description of Virtual Program

OVERVIEW:

Students will utilize online learning curricula to receive credits toward graduation. Instruction and assessment will be **online**. Final exams will be virtual. You will set final exams up with your mentor teacher. Course credit and grade will be awarded upon successful completion.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE:

- Virtual classes open June 16, 2020 beginning at 10am.

FOR STUDENTS WHO REGISTER BY JUNE 10:

Students may attend an **optional** orientation via Zoom on June 15. You will receive an email with details on how to join the Zoom meeting. Students who do not need to attend the orientation may begin their course on June 16.

FOR STUDENTS WHO REGISTER AFTER JUNE 10:

Students may attend an **optional** orientation via Zoom on June 17. You will receive an email with details on how to join the Zoom meeting.

- Classes will take an *average* of two hours per day for one class and four hours per day for two classes. Students will work to complete the selected curricula with due diligence during the scheduled program time.
- Students taking **ONE** virtual course must complete their final exam on or **before July 28, 12:00pm**.
- Students taking **TWO** virtual courses must complete their final exam for their first course by **July 8, 12:00pm**, and will not be allowed to begin their second course until that final exam is completed and recorded.
- Students taking **TWO** virtual courses must complete the final exam for their second course by **July 30, 12:00pm**.
- The Virtual Lab time/location/availability is TBD based on COVID 19 response requirements.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Students will be considered for the virtual program based on the recommendation of their administrator or guidance counselor. To register for the virtual program visit: www.troyceonline.com. The terms and conditions must be marked online as approved by the parent/guardian. Failure to meet the terms and conditions of the contract may result in non-admittance or removal from the program.

REFUND/DROP/TRANSFER POLICY:

All transfer and drop fees are waived for 2020.

Refunds must be requested **either** before the first quiz is completed **or** before **July 17**, if no quiz has been taken. Once the class is 30% completed, a grade will be recorded, even if the class is dropped. This means an "E" will be reported if the class is not completed after the student reaches 30% completion. The student and parent/guardian understand that there will be no refunds once a student completes the first quiz, or after July 17, if no quiz has been taken. Terms and Conditions

In order to participate in the Troy School District Virtual Program, the student and parent/guardian agree to the following terms and conditions below and mark the waiver online.

- 1) The student will work to complete the selected curricula with due diligence during the scheduled program time. Staying on target with timelines is the key to success.
- 2) The student must take the Final Exam for each class between the hours of 8am to 12pm, Monday through Friday until Thursday, July 30 (see front page for exam deadlines for one and two classes). Be sure to give yourself enough time to complete the final exam by 12pm. **Under no circumstance will a student be allowed to take their final exam after Thursday, July 30, 12pm.** Any student who is unable to take their final exam will receive a zero on the exam and will receive a grade that includes that score in their final average.
- 3) The student agrees to abide by all TSD acceptable use policies while working on school district computers and/or software. Failure to abide by these policies may result in loss of computer privileges and dismissal from the program.
- 4) The student and parent/guardian understand that there will be no refunds once a student completes the first quiz or after July 17, if no quiz has been taken. Once the class is 30% completed, an "E" grade will be recorded, even if the class is dropped.
- 5) The Final Exam is worth 30% of the final grade in ALL virtual courses. Additionally, there are no A+ Grades issued during the session. The highest grade possible earned (93% or greater) is an A.
