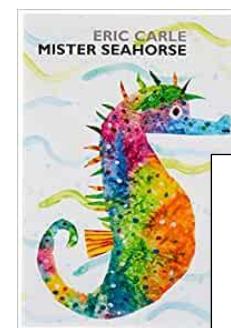
Grow an egg box garden.
