

Have a think about Pig's behaviour. Create a poster which shows at least three things that make a good friend.	Create an owner's manual on how to look after an animal you know well. This could be either your pet, favourite animal or an animal you have created. Ensure you include written instructions and pictures.	Write the similarities and differences between Pig and Trevor.
Go on a 3D shape treasure hunt around your home. Try to find a sphere, cube, cuboid, cylinder and pyramid.	Choose a number between 10 and 20. See which of these numbers can be split into groups of 2's. Then do the same to see which numbers can be divided into groups of 5's and 10's. Use counters, pencils, pebbles or any objects which can be used as counters.	With an adult, find out what positive big events and news stories happened in the year you were born. You can write these or act one of them out!
Build a 3D model or draw and label your design of a dog house for Pig and Trevor. What shapes do you think will be best to use?	List some subtraction facts to 40 e.g. $40-1=39$ $40-2=38$ etc. Use objects to help. Have a go at writing out the number sentences. Do you notice any patterns?	Plants! Find out what these two words mean: Evergreen and deciduous. Research some plants that belong to these groups, draw them and label them. This could be done by making your own plant classification sheet!
Spend 20 minutes practising your focus spelling words. Make sure you can use them in a sentence.	Log onto Mathletics and Times Tables Rockstars and complete some of the games.	Log onto phonics play: Username: march20 Password: home Choose Phase 5 and the game 'Flashcards Time Challenge'.

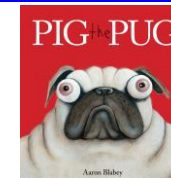
