CONTINUITY OF LEARNING PLAN

The IMS educational team has worked closely with the IPS Administrative Team and Intermediate School District to create this Learning Plan. The plan is structured and designed to provide students with multiple opportunities to stay engaged. The online template is the same as the paper packet. Students will be challenged to complete Project-Based Learning activities along with numerous other activities tied to our curriculum. The educational plan is broken into Part A and Part B. Part A will cover April 16th-May 8th and Part B will cover May 11th-June 3rd. Part B will be made available on May 7th.

FRAMEWORK (*Together we will*)

- Students will be expected to:
 - Participate in Mathematics activities for a minimum of 30 minutes per weekday
 - Participate in English Language Arts activities for a minimum of 30 minutes per weekday
 - Complete one Project Based Learning Activity per week
 - Explore as many of the Enrichment Activities as possible
 - Communicate with teachers each week via email, Google Classroom, phone conversations, etc..
- Teachers will:
 - Have weekly office hours for real-time conversations
 - Provide feedback and encourage students
 - Post office hours on the web-page, in packets and via Google Classroom
- Administration, Counselors and other support staff will:
 - Have weekly office hours for real-time conversations
- Parents will:
 - Encourage and motivate along with the teaching staff
