## 1. Cap and Gown Distribution Update - TIME CHANGE!!!

To all our seniors and their families: I'm excited to announce we have plans for Cap and Gown Distribution on **Thursday May 14**. Students will be arriving according to this **schedule**:

Last names A-G: 2:00 - 3:00
Last names H-P: 3:00 - 4:00
Last names Q-Z: 4:00 - 5:00

I had to change the time from what I announced last week because I had forgotten that North Creek is a "meal distribution center" during the middle of each day and having two events at the same time in the same parking lot was just not possible. Shifting the time to later in the afternoon will also avoid conflicts with AP exams and will allow our teens to be better rested so they drive safer!

The distribution will take place in the North (Student) Parking lot and **no student will be allowed out of their car**. In order to prevent traffic jams, we are going to stage the cars in the North Lot using the zig-zag pattern shown on this map (click **HERE**). Students will enter off of 188th Street on the north side of campus and will exit back onto 188th. To the extent possible, it's important that students stick to their appointed time for arrival as the caps and gowns are sorted alphabetically and we cannot have all 400 kids arrive at the same time.

We will have NCHS Staff members on hand to both ensure that students remain in their cars but also to waive and wish our kids well as they pick up their caps and gowns. Unfortunately, due to strict social distancing rules, **no family members or friends will be allowed on campus for any reason**. I hope you can respect that we are trying to make this a very special event for our seniors and we cannot risk anyone breaking the Governor's orders which tell us that no groups of any size can form.

The LEAP (Leadership through Education, Activities and Personal Development) Committee meets five (5) times annually to engage in leadership activities, visit with guest speakers and collaborate on various service projects. All travel expenses associated with attending the meetings are reimbursed by the WIAA. The summer after their junior year, LEAP Committee members attend a summer retreat designed to strengthen leadership skills and set LEAP Committee goals for the upcoming school year.

If LEAP Committee members meet all criteria expected of them over their two-year term, they receive a \$500 scholarship to the institution of their choice when they graduate.
