## 1. When will classes resume, and is the school year going to be extended?

Following guidelines set by New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all Delbarton classes and activities are canceled through the remainder of the 2019-20 school year. For students in grades 7-11, the school year will end as scheduled on June 3.
